Are you eligible?

You may be eligible for HACC or CCSP services if you are an older person, a person with a disability, or a carer. Agencies providing services will discuss your needs and eligibility during an assessment and will then provide you with information about your choices. It is important to understand that in some circumstances there may be more people wanting services than there are services available. It is the agencies' responsibility to make sure services are allocated fairly and on the basis of need. However if these government subsidised services are not available when you need them, there are some commercial/private services which may be able to assist.

How much does it cost?

Each service will provide information about its fees during an initial discussion of your needs. If you are not able to pay, you cannot be denied a HACC or CCSP service.
