POLICY PURPOSE / OBJECTIVES:

1. To maintain residential amenity following Council roadworks adjoining property boundaries.

POLICY STATEMENT:

- 1. Where roadworks require the alteration of boundary fences the existing fence will be suitably adjusted at Council's expense using existing materials. New materials will be used if supplied by the owner. A new type of fence will be constructed if the owner agrees to pay the difference in cost.
- 2. Vehicular and pedestrian entrances will be reinstated in like manner and to no worse a condition than that previously existing.
