DOG LIFETIME REGISTRATION AND FEE INFORMATION



The NSW Government require the owners of dogs and cats to pay a lifetime registration fee due at 12 weeks of age or upon their first transfer. The purpose of the following information is to help you understand how to register your pet and what fee/s you will need to pay.

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR PET

You can register your pet by creating a profile on the NSW Office of Local Government website: petregistry.nsw.gov.au and 'claiming' your pet.

Please ensure you are on this website to pay the lifetime registration fee as there are a number of privately run databases that appear in search engines.

ANNUAL PERMIT

In addition to lifetime registration on the 1 July 2020 the NSW Government introduced an annual permit fee for restricted breeds or declared dangerous dogs.

 If your dog is a restricted breed and/or declared dangerous you must pay a \$230 annual permit fee

Please be advised that a late fee of \$22 is applicable if you do not pay the registration fee for your dog within 28 days after the date on which the animal is required to be registered.
