- In general Tree Applications will not be accepted for any property that is simultaneously subject to a development application or for a complying development certificate.

6. Applications to remove a tree will **NOT** be processed without the owner / agent's written consent.
7. Tree applications will not be accepted for any property that is simultaneously subject to a development application.
8. A credit card payment can only be accepted for applications submitted online via Council's website.
