### Spring Fest Hornsby – Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> November 2024

We wish to advise that Council's newest and largest community event of 2024, Spring Fest Hornsby will be held on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> November from 2:00pm to 9:00pm.

This will take place on the Westside Precinct of Hornsby along a section of Peats Ferry Road, Dural Lane, William Street and Dural Street carparks. The goal of this event is to bring the local community together, encourage more activity and contribute to the vibrancy and character of the Westside Precinct. It is a family-friendly event. We will feature some of Sydney's best food vendors, pop up bars, a free entertainment program featuring roving street performers and 7 hours of live music, art and free activities for the whole family.

In order for this event to occur, there will need to be road closures at the following locations:

- Peats Ferry Road between Station Street and Coronation Street from 10:00am through to midnight Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> November.
- The top entry to Dural Lane will be closed to traffic from 8:00am to Midnight Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> November.
- The William/Dural Street carparks will not be available from 7:00pm Friday 15<sup>th</sup> November to Midnight Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> November.

A professional traffic management company will manage the diversion routes to alleviate any traffic congestion in the surrounding affected areas. Parking marshals will be stationed at various locations to make this process as efficient as possible for residents, businesses and attendees.

Local police and transport companies are being consulted in the planning process for this road closure.
