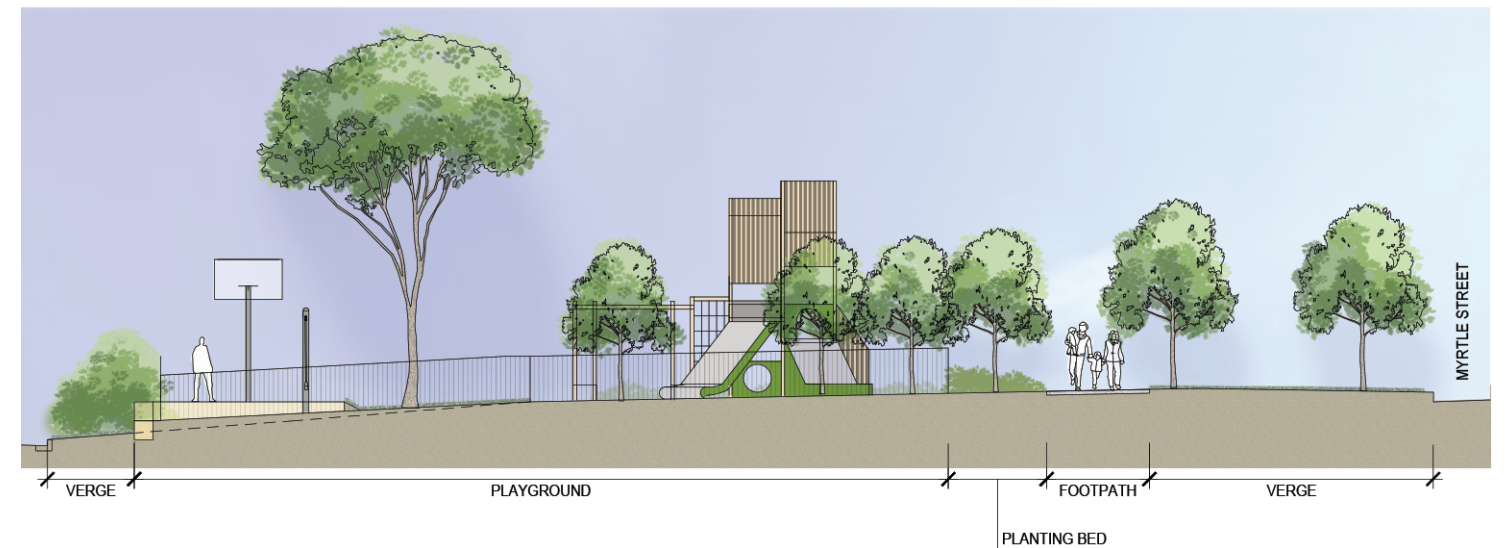
PROJECT DESCRIPTION

In October-November 2024 Council consulted with the community regarding their vision for Charles Curtis Park. An online survey, site meeting and written submissions were collated to inform a brief for a DRAFT Landscape concept plan. The attached plan takes on board the feedback Council received.

Design brief:

- Provision of activity opportunities and play equipment with a priority on the toddler and early primary age bracket 1-9yrs.
- Create a community meeting place
- Basketball hoop with hardstand to be relocated to a more appropriate location with improved surfacing.
- Shade provision through positioning equipment closer to existing trees, and new tree plantings along with the provision of picnic table under shelter.
- Additional seating outside of the fenced playground area so that users can stay longer and make more use of the open space.
- Improved access to the park through the installation of a footpath to Willowtree Street (2025/2026 delivery plan) and a footpath as part of these works to the Pine Street frontage
- Improve open lawn area for flexibility of use
- Fencing to playground only.
- Retain, protect and manage existing trees

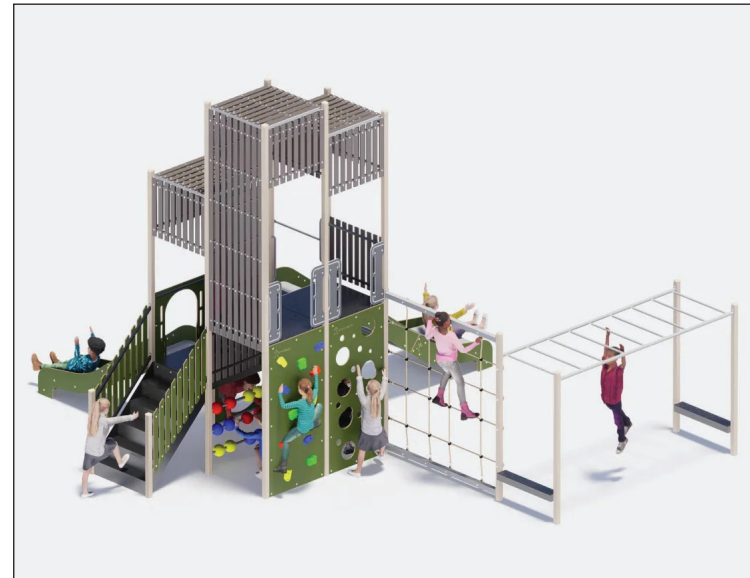

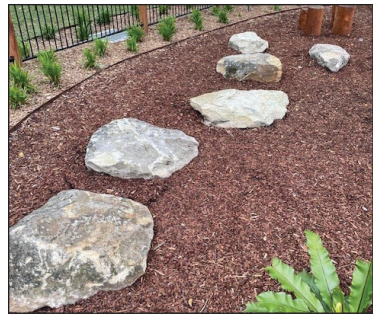

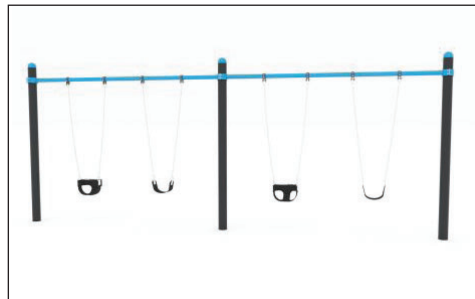

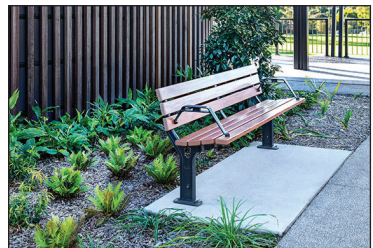

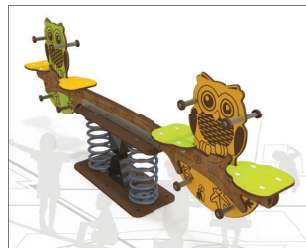
