Installation of Fixed Speed Camera Pacific Highway between Cowan and Brooklyn

Safer Roads Program

Transport for NSW is improving road safety on the Pacific highway between Cowan and Brooklyn.

Following requests from community members and Hornsby Shire Council to address speed-related incidents in the area, Transport for NSW will install a fixed speed camera on the Pacific Highway at Cowan.

The fixed speed camera will be operational in May 2025.

What work are we doing?

This work includes:

- establishing a temporary work site
- locating existing underground services
- using machinery to cut into the road
- installing electrical cables underground
- installing the pole for the fixed speed camera
- installing an outdoor electrical box
- trimming trees where required
- removing and replacing existing signs
- potholing work to install new signs.

Transport for NSW will also be installing 'No Stopping' signs along the Pacific Highway between Muogamarra Field Studies Trail and Brooklyn Road, Cowan during standard work hours from **Thursday 3 April** to **Thursday 17 April**, weather permitting.

When and where we'll be working

Work will take place **over 16 night shifts** between **Monday 7 April** and **Wednesday 7 May**, weather and site conditions permitting. Work will be paused over the Easter long weekend.

Working hours are from **8pm to 5am, Monday to Friday**. Nosier work will take place before midnight.

Further information will be provided should there be significant changes to the installation schedule.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closures and reduced speed limits
- noise from machinery and equipment.


Traffic changes
