NorthConnex early work activities: survey work – Night work on Hills M2 Motorway and M1 Pacific Motorway

From 4 May 2015, topographical surveys and investigations to locate and mark the locations of underground utilities will take place at night along sections of the Hills M2 Motorway and the M1 Pacific Motorway (as indicated in the attached map). This work will take around three weeks to complete.

This work is required to support the detailed design of NorthConnex and will involve:
Topographical survey of road carriageways and nearby drainage features
Searching for locations of utility services; and
Marking locations in different colours.

Plant includes hand-held equipment and surveying tools, lighting towers and light vehicles. All work will take place behind the motorway noise walls and is unlikely to cause any impact on nearby residents.

To minimise impact on motorists work will occur outside peak times between 9pm and 5am. Traffic management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Variable message signs will be in place to advise the changes to traffic conditions.
