Subject: Proposed "Bus Zone" Changes

REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of proposed changes to an existing "Bus Zone" at the frontage of Oakhill Drive Public School, to support services of CDC NSW Bus Company.

SUBJECT

Council has been approached by **Oakhill Drive Public School** in Castle Hill, requesting a review of the "Bus Zone" at the frontage of the school.

It has been reported that car drivers often park in the "Bus Bay" around bus pick-up time, causing buses to be unable to access the "Bus Zone" area when in operation.

Subsequent liaison with CDC NSW Bus Company revealed the existing "Bus Zone" times do not match new operational times of bus services.

Currently the "Bus Zone" for this Bus Stop (ID 2154-330) is a timed "Bus Zone 3pm - 4pm".

A proposal has been developed for the following changes:

- 1. Removal of "Bus Zone 3pm 4pm" signs for the Bus Stop.
- 2. Installation of 'Bus Zone, 2.30pm 4pm School Days" signs. The location of signs will remain unchanged.
- 3. Existing part time "No Parking, 8am-9am, School Days" restrictions at the "Bus Bay" to remain unchanged.

Plan of the proposal is attached.

CONSULTATION

The changes to the operation times of the "Bus Zone" are essential to deliver efficient public transport services.

Parking restrictions will only apply during bus services for afternoon school pick-up.

The changes to the operation times of the "Bus Zone" in the "Bus Bay" will not affect residents, and have been developed in consultation with the bus operator and Oakhill Drive Public School.

Further consultation is not considered necessary.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

- 1. Existing signs in Oakhill Drive, Castle Hill (ID 2154-330) be changed from "Bus Zone, 3pm 4pm" to "Bus Zone, 2.30pm 4pm School Days".
- 2. Existing part-time "No Parking, 8am 9am, School Days" restrictions at the "Bus Bay" are to remain unchanged.
