SOUTHERN AREA DESIGNATED USES

- General daytime passive recreational activities
- Area to be used by both walk-in campers and campers requiring vehicular access

- Improved views to the water
- Passive recreation
- Riverine interpretation or artwork

New tree planting

Existing tree canopy to be increased with native plantings

Bank works

- Stabilise banks by regrading and fencing off to encourage mangrove recolonisation
- Reduce accessible gap to riverbank to minimise erosion

New bushwalking track

- New link track to Hornsby heights

- General daytime passive recreational activities

New riverside interpretation walk

- Links north and south sections of Great North Walk
- Provides main north/south pedestrian path for Reserve
- Interpretation and seating along path

Remove existing access track and landscape over

Existing stair structure

- Existing stairs to be upgraded

CROSSLAND CONVENTION and FIELD STUDY CENTRE

Improve management of existing sealed carparking area and extend landscaping to accommodate new riverside walk

Re-configure corner of sealed area to provide defined right-angle parking

Discontinue entry road-side parking and replace with landscaping / bus turning arrangement

New turning road

- For bus and car turning and drop off
- Bus parking bays

New entry orientation signage

Relocated playground

New carpark

- General maintenance access

Possible future extension of road with additional carpark

Existing toilet building refurbished

- New fit-out and extra toilets
- New enlarged septic and holding tanks for peak use
- Existing leach drain effluent treatment system maintained

Re-organise boat launching area

- Stabilisation works to ramp
- Stabilisation works and mangrove restoration to adjacent banks
- Removable bollards to ramp allowing use by hand-carried light-weight craft only
- Public use of ramp for trailer-launched boats to be discontinued

Re-organise and refurbish existing central parking area

- Restrict parking to sealed area by bollards or wheelstops
- Improved efficiency of sealed area through better defined parking arrangements
- Reseal carpark surface
- New drainage swale to west to control run-off
- Improve vehicular circulation

- Passive recreation
- Riverine interpretation or artwork
- Location to be confirmed
- Structures to provide improved views to creek

NORTHERN AREA DESIGNATED USES

- General daytime passive recreational activities
- Area to be exclusively for walk-in campers. No vehicular access for campers

Over the longer term progressively reduce areas of existing shrub planting and return to trees and grass

New toilet building

- Landscape-sensitive architectural character
- New enlarged septic and holding tanks for peak use
- Existing landscaped effluent treatment zone for toilets to be maintained
- Location to be confirmed

Low lying areas to be regenerated

Topdressing and Turfing

To increase usable recreational space adjacent to wetland and reduce tidal flooding of developed park areas while allowing low lying areas to regenerate
