REFERRAL OF TRAFFIC MATTER FOR COMMENT OR OBJECTION, IF ANY

SUMMARY

This report details the traffic implications of a proposed temporary 'Works Zone' in Citrus Avenue to accommodate the construction of 13 townhouses, with a basement carpark at 9 and 11 Citrus Avenue, Hornsby.

SUBJECT

Council has received a request from the property owner for a temporary 'Works Zone' at the front boundary of 9 and 11 Citrus Avenue.

The building works project is in accordance with approved DA/156/2019 - Construction of 13 townhouses with a basement carpark.

The initially proposed 20 lineal metres long 'Works Zone' is required to accommodate deliveries and construction vehicles during construction which has commenced at the site and is required for a period of 13 weeks initially. Providing the temporary 'Works Zone' along the site's frontages will minimise disruption to traffic when construction vehicles require access to the site.

CONSULTATION

No further consultation is required as the location of the proposed 'Works Zone' is along the frontage of the construction site.

RECOMMENDATION THAT

1. 20m long 'Works Zone 7am-5:00pm, Mon-Sat' be approved for installation at 9 and 11 Citrus Avenue, Hornsby for the duration of the construction activity (initially 13 weeks) in accordance with Council's 2023/2024 Fees and Charges.
